Any photographs taken by parents or photographers on game days at GUFC grounds and given to the club for use on our website, social media, public relations, marketing and newsletters are covered off as players register.

On the Play Football system we have the following disclaimer that must be checked/ticked before registration is complete.

By registering with GUFC you are agreeing to abide by the following Codes of Conduct and to the use of photography around the grounds on game days:

We are aware that occasionally there is a family who needs their child to remain "invisible" because they may be in a dangerous situation. It is the responsibility of that family to advise us in writing and we alert their team manager. If you are in this situation please email <u>contact@gufc.org.au</u> with the title NO PHOTOS PLEASE along with the player's name, their age group and team name. Any photos of that team will not be used for GUFC purposes.

We look forward to receiving game day photos from families for our files and so that we can start showing them off in our social media. The photographer will be thanked (and tagged where applicable).

Any games played on private grounds (eg private schools etc) must observe the photo policy of the private ground.
